The exhibition at the Malzfabrik shows a project from the University of Europe for Applied Sciences (www.ue-germany.de), which has been running since 2019, that has documented the area along the Vjosa River in Albania photographically and on film. Here, the Albanian government planned to intervene in one of the last free-flowing rivers in Europe with more than thirty dams by 2022, which would have had the consequence of destroying this unique biotope and the surrounding centuries-old villages. NGOs like ECOAlbania, which are also cooperation partners of the UE project, tried to prevent the dam from being built. In June 2022, they succeeded: the Albanian government signed a declaration of intent to establish the Vjosa National Park. The project is to be continued in the longer term in the spirit of consolidation. Vjosa - The Last Untamed River in Europe shows 150 photographs, installations and illustrations as well as various video works by students and several teachers.
