



German Society for Photography EMERGING PHOTOGRAPHER AWARD Award of the DGPh Section Art, Market & Law

Nomination Specifications for the Award

Open to emerging photographers on the art market and artists working with photography who have not been active in the art market for more than three years at the time of their nomination.

Required Documents

The following documents must be submitted online for nomination. (Note that only fully completed nominations will be considered.)

- Contact details: First and last name, address, e-mail, telephone, internet address (if available) of the nominated artist and the nominator.
- A brief synopsis justifying the nomination. Format: max. 1 DIN A4 page.
- A short biography outlining the nominee's most important personal and artistic milestones, plus any publication and exhibition credits. Format: max. 1 A4 page.
- 5 to 10 images displaying examples of the nominee's work. Format: JPEG, maximum size of 1,024 KB, 2,048 pixels wide, RGB color space only.

Submission Deadline

The complete documentation must be uploaded to the <u>EMERGING PHOTOGRAPHER AWARDs</u> page by May 23, 2024, midnight (CET).

The Prize

Prize money totaling €3,000, fully sponsored by Whitewall, will be made available to the winner. Any honorable mentions awards will not be entitled to cash awards. The prizewinner will be invited to the award ceremony, which will take place on November 8, 2024 at Paris Photo, plus will be compensated for a 2nd class train ticket and one overnight stay in Paris.
